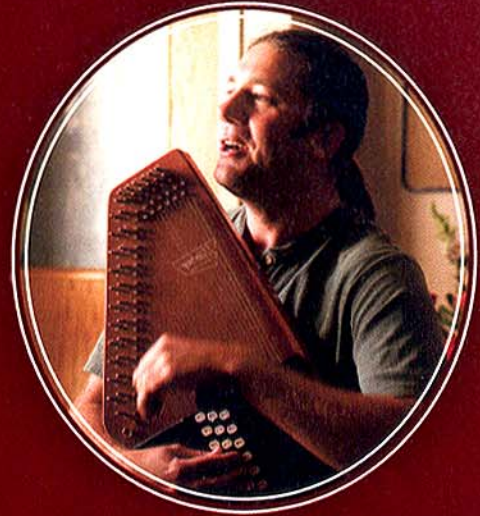




Swan Songs

Swan Songs fulfills musical wishes at the end of life by organizing private concerts for individuals with a terminal illness. At their request, a favorite style of music or musician is brought directly to the home or facility. The concert allows patient, family and friends to focus beyond the illness and come together through the medium of music.

Musicians perform without electronic amplification and can go to private homes, hospitals, or other residential facilities. Swan Songs has organized concerts of Scottish folk songs, bagpipe music, Elvis Presley songs, gospel hymns, and more.

How it works:

1. The patient (or someone on their behalf) requests an artist or style of music they would like, and suggests times for a concert.
2. Swan Songs contacts the musicians and schedules a concert time, respecting the family's privacy throughout the process.
3. The performers are compensated directly by Swan Songs so the patient and their family bear no financial obligation.

About Swan Songs: In 1993, Austin musician Christine Albert and psychotherapist Gaea Logan informally began bringing local musicians to the bedside of music lovers nearing the end of their life. The joy these concerts brought to everyone inspired Ms. Albert and Ms. Logan to found Swan Songs in 2005. Ms. Albert currently serves as president of a six member board of directors and manages the project on a volunteer basis. Although the concerts are offered at no charge to the families, the musicians are paid for their time through the generosity of private donations, corporate funding, grants and fundraising events.
